At our August 1, 2006 meeting, the Historic Preservation Commission had an opportunity to meet with the applicant and the architect for the project referenced above. The proposal is to repair and/or replace the steeple of the church and it's supporting structures.

The Commission's primary concern was that the submitted building permit plans showed complete replacement rather than repair. The Commission wanted to be certain that, wherever possible, the structure be repaired rather than replaced in order to maintain its architectural integrity.

In approving the Eagle Harbor Church for placement on the Historic Register, the commission found that the Church met several criteria including criterion number 2, for eligibility. That criterion says that the structure

"Embodies the distinctive architectural characteristics of a type, time period, style, or method of design or construction, or represents a significant and distinguishable entity whose components may lack individual distinction."

By a vote of 4-1, with one abstention, the Commission made the following motion:

"The Commission approves a certificate of appropriateness for the Eagle Harbor Church tower restoration project subject to the assurance that it will be repaired to the greatest extent possible."




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
