The plans submitted have been reviewed resulting in the following comments:

- 1. This comment was issued in 2009: If a fire sprinkler system and/or fire alarm system is being installed, or an existing system requires modifications, plans shall be submitted to the Building Department for Fire Department review. Please be aware that while the scope of this permit will not require a fire sprinkler system to be installed, it is quite possible that future work may require such a system per BIMC requirements. Please plan accordingly.
- 2. BIMC 20.04.100 D3 states: If a building permit is required in the remodeling of an existing structure of 5,000 or more square feet total floor area, the entire structure shall be fully sprinklered as required in subsection A.1 or A.2 of this section, whichever may apply.
- 3. The type of occupancy and the risks associated with it pose sufficient hazards, as described in BIMC 20.04.100 to warrant the installation of an approved sprinkler and fire alarm system.
- 4. The Fire Marshal will meet with the building owner and building official to determine an appropriate timeline for the installation of the systems.
