I am a homeowner in the Wind Song Loop neighborhood, across from the proposed site of Madrona School. Traffic, parking and entry/exit from school property may be a serious problem. They propose 45 spaces for teacher parking...great, but that's 90 entries and exits on Madison Ave N. They propose 200 students will attend - another 350+/- entries and exits on Madison. This is already a very busy road - especially with the hourly backups on Hwy 305. Cars speed up Madison coming from the ferry to bypass the backups. Now will backups be on Madison as well? Will the speed limit be changed again on Madison??!!

I was recently driving past Hyla School when it let out at 3:00. There were at least 15-18 cars at the entry - backed up on the road coming from both ways - some cars trying to leave while others trying to crowd in. They have only 90 students. Madrona has 200. Both are on 2 lane busy roads. Plus Hyla has an agreement with Kitsap Transit to take some students to Winslow which alleviates some cars.
