- noise; the project can only increase the noise in this quiet neighborhood
- traffic; Winslow is already literally bursting at the seams
- light; a 24-hour hotel facility can only create more light pollution
- water & sewer; additional burdens for an already-overtaxed system
- character; fundamental, irreversible change to the nature of the neighborhood
