I have several concerns, but top most is the concern about the amount of water that will be used. The architect said that even with rain catchments, they will use 600,000 gallons over what would be allowed as a "living building". PLEASE let's protect our water supply.

Another objection I have is too the size of the project. That property is zoned for a small inn of up to 15 rooms. An inn similar to the Eagle Harbor Inn would be lovely there. But this large project with a restaurant is not going to fit well in the neighborhood. I am a neighbor so this issue is huge for me. Especially the late night revelers.
