I have just been made aware of the developers proposed changes to the hotel they are planning on building on Winslow Way by adding more (11) rooms and parking spaces (11)! As an effort to provide "housing" for staff.

Perhaps my biggest concern regarding this project and that of the Planning Commission's recommendations is the scale of this project. Building a hotel with now 98 rooms and 145 parking spaces in a space zoned for a 15 room boutique hotel/inn hardly seems like a compromise of any measure. What part of "too big" do they not understand?

The inclusion of a "bandstand" on a property purported not to be an "event" center is questionable to begin with and the idea that a vegetation buffer on the east side of the property to contain any "noise" factors is really ridiculous.

I fail to see how the proposed changes make the project any more desirable in its location. I understand that these proposed changes will go before the Planning Commission yet again for consideration. I hope they will take into account the environmental impact the planned building will make.
