Hi Phyllis,

The Public Participation Meeting is required for preapplication proposals that will require applications for a Major Site Plan Review Permit or a Major Conditional Use Permit. This proposal will require applications for both of these permit types. The purpose of this meeting is outlined in the attached Resolution 2010-32. The goal is to inform and engage the public early in the planning process in order to address any questions and concerns.

The proposal is in the preapplication stages and has not yet been submitted. Review by the Planning Commission will not occur for many months.

To my knowledge, the applicant is not pursuing a HDDP.
