I am very concerned with the proposed plans being considered at the Bloedel.

The exit driveway relocation will put traffic out on to Agate Point Road right ahead of the blind corner of Dolphin and Agate Point Road. This is not safe.

Allowing large tour buses will add to traffic congestion in the neighborhood. This will make it very difficult to make left turns on to Highway 305. Right now at the end of their business day it is not uncommon to see 8 or more cars backed up on Agatewood turning on to 305. This is the ONLY exit from our neighborhood. Long lines of traffic on Agate are not only an inconvenience but also impact our safety.

The Bloedel needs to rethink this plan. Have they even considered opening up the road connected to Hidden Cove? Doing so would give our neighborhood relief from traffic.
