Water resources

My major concern about this project is the huge demand for water for a 75 room hotel with a spa, meeting spaces and restaurant. This drain on resources ultimately falls on Bainbridge taxpayers. With all the requirements on homeowners for "recharging aquifers", we have a proposal that will suck up major amounts of water for laundry, dishes, showers and spa for mostly tourists. I see this as a major conflict in City policy.

Parking
