

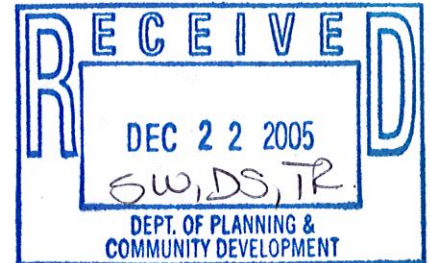

Camp Major Hopkins at 900 Park Avenue on Bainbridge Island

has been listed in the National Register of Historic Places, where it joins other properties which contribute to the rich cultural heritage of Washington State. The Camp is historically significant for its direct association to New Deal federal relief programs and as an example of the types of projects undertaken in local communities as part of these relief efforts. Additionally, Camp Major Hopkins is significant as an intact example of rustic architecture.
