Ms. Hillier:

As I understand your agency's probable decision, the limited access into upper Fletcher Bay via the resulting narrow navigable channel, will affect ingress and egress to our dock. The granting of the proposed ramp and dock off the Hanson's point property will be unprecedented in its lengthy walkway to a large dock into that channel.

We oppose that much intrusion. Also, the sight lines and views from our homes will be compromised by this aluminum structure.

At the very least, a natural color as a condition of the permit, such as brown, should be required to mitigate this intrusion.

We certainly support their request for a dock off their bay property, but not this outsized, intrusive scale.
