An additional item of importance concerning environmental impacts at or near Little Manzanita Bay is the recent acquisition by The Land Trust. At the mouth of the North Branch of Manzanita Bay is a large parcel that has been accepted as a conservation easement that limits environmental impacts to the watershed. This is not on the shoreline but highlights the importance of environmental protection of the entire watershed and the shoreline impacts of the bay.
