

Project Description: Bio-  
retention facilities and  
vegetated slopes will oc-  
cur along Wardwell NE  
and its intersections  
with Bucsit Lane and  
McRedmond. The pro-  
ject will reconstruct NE  
Wardwell to accommo-  
date water quality treat-  
ment outside the desig-  
nated wetland area  
using bioretention  
swales and cells and  
compost amended  
vegetated slopes. Water  
from offsite will be col-  
lected and redistributed  
thru a closed convey-  
ance system. The pro-  
ject will also replace a  
concrete culvert that re-  
stricts flow with a new  
fish passage box culvert  
that will reduce nutrient  
loading, restore wetland  
conductivity and provide  
fish passage.

Environmental Review:  
This proposal is subject  
to State Environmental  
Policy Act (SEPA) re-  
view as provided in  
WAC 197-11-800. The  
City, acting as lead  
agency expects to issue  
a Mitigated Determina-  
tion of Non-significance  
(MDNS) threshold de-  
termination for this pro-  
posal. Utilizing the op-  
tional DNS process  
provided in WAC 197-  
11-355, the comment  
period specified in this  
notice may be the only  
opportunity to comment  
on the environmental  
impact of this proposal.  
The Proposal may in-  
clude mitigation meas-  
ures under applicable  
codes, and the project

review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an EIS is prepared. A copy of the subsequent threshold determination for the proposal may be obtained upon request.

Comment period: The City will not take a final action on the proposal nor make a threshold determination for 14 days from the date of this notice. Any person may comment on the proposal and/or the SPEA review. Additionally, any person may participate in a public hearing, if any, and may request a copy of any decision. For consideration under SEPA environmental review, comments must be submitted by Friday, April 21, 2017.
